

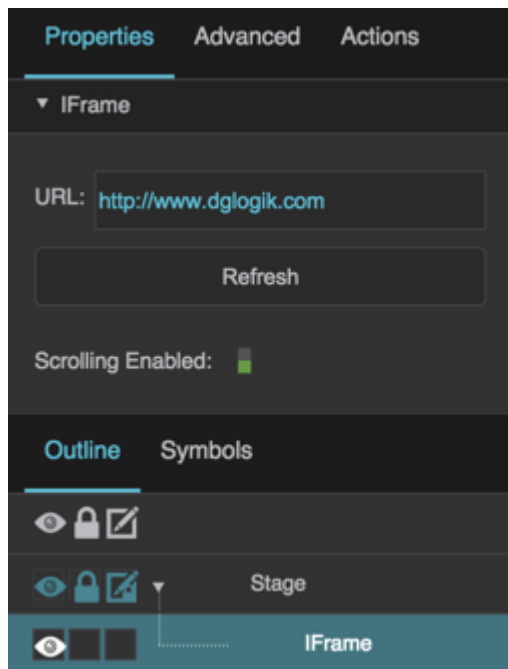
IFrame Properties

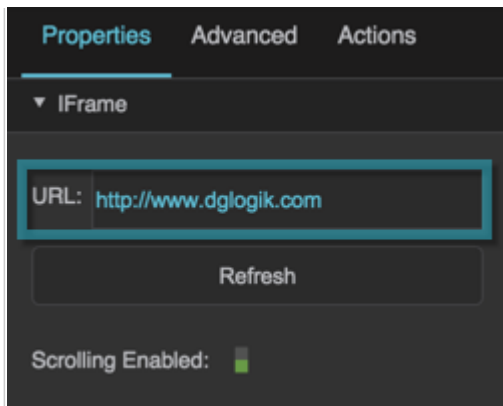
The IFrame properties in the Property Inspector

Click to display/hide all elements

URL

Specifies the URL to be displayed within the IFrame.

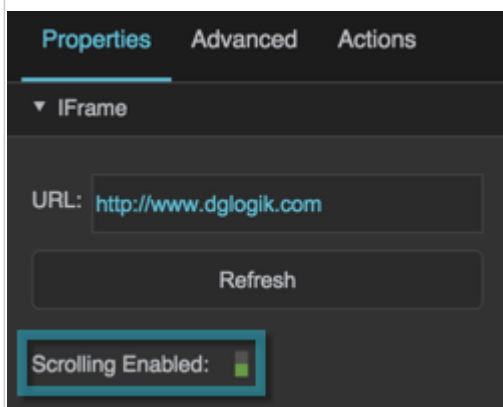
This allows you to use third-party or your own standalone CSS, JavaScript, and HTML components in your DGLux5 application. Your custom components will behave as if they were native DGLux5 components.



The URL property

IFrame Scrolling

Specifies whether scrolling is enabled on the IFrame component. If scrolling is disabled, then content that overflows the component is clipped.
