Block Group:	Statistical Functions

The Maximum block returns the greatest value in a list of arguments.



## Note

If none of the **input n** values is a number, the Maximum block outputs infinity.

## Input/Output Property

The following property of the Maximum block can take input and give output.

- **input n (number)**

**input n** specifies one of the input values for the statistical function.

## Output Property


The following property of the Maximum block can give output but cannot take input.

- **output (number)**

**output** returns the greatest of the input values.
