

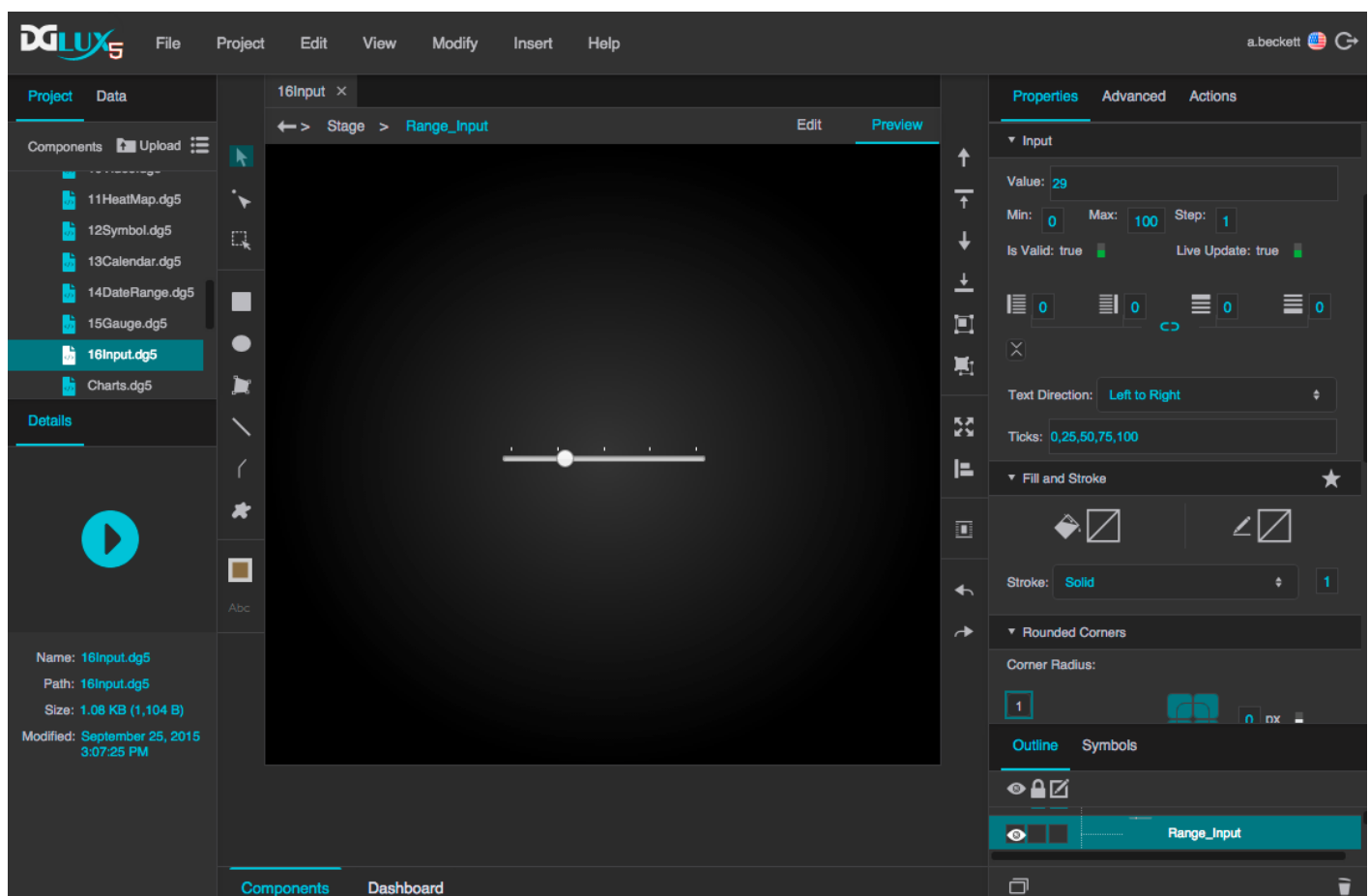
Range Input

The range input component allows the user to specify an approximate number in a range, for when the exact value is not important.

To use this component, first you insert it by selecting **Insert > Form > Range Input**. Then, you configure style and behavior using [properties](#).
