

# Project Permissions

To edit project permissions, you use the Project Properties dialog.

---

## How to Make a Project Viewable by Anyone

These steps let any person view the project, regardless of whether the person is logged in to DGLux5.

To make a project viewable to anyone:


1. Open the project.
  2. Choose **Project > Project Properties**.
  3. For **Who has access**, choose **Anyone with Link**.
  4. Make sure that **guest** is set to **can view**.

## How to Change Editing Permissions on a Project

You can give access or restrict access to a project for a user.

To change editing permissions:

1. Open the project.
2. Choose **Project > Project Properties**.
3. Make sure that **Who has access** is set to **specific people**.
4. Next to the username, choose **Can edit** or **Can view**.

If the username is not listed, enter the username, then choose **Can edit** or **Can view** and click **Add** .
